This year is a special one for the entire SOFOSH team and we are proud that SOFOSH will step into the Golden Jubilee year in the month of September 2013. It's been a long road for us and walking on this challenging path would have not been possible without the support of our innumerous donors, supporters and well-wishers. SOFOSH commenced its patient welfare services in the year 1964 and gradually broadened its horizons. It was in 1974 when our Child Care Centre, Shreevatsa, came into existence. Today SOFOSH is also one amongst the leading licensed adoption agencies in Pune.

To continue with our services towards the needy sections of our society, we call for incessant support from all of you as always. We incur a cost of Rs. 5000/- per day to feed all the children in our centre. At any given time, we care for about 100 children at our Centre. (SHREEVATSA and TARA) Similarly, with the price hikes in fuel prices over the past few months, it is a challenge and an additional financial strain on the institution. We incur a cost of RS.2000/- per day towards the fuel expenses (including the gas and the electricity charges). We are seeking to create a fraternity of 365 friends, each one undertaking to support a day's cost of our food or fuel expenses. We appeal to you to be a part of this fraternity called "SHARING", and support our program by sponsoring the food/fuel on any calendar date/s that is important for you. Hope to receive a helping hand from our well-wishers which would certainly ameliorate our financial strain. 🌣

BURNS CASE

Piya Shinde, a 20 year newly married young girl proved to be one of the countless victims of marital violence. She got married about eight months back to a boy who worked as a driver on daily wages basis. This marriage was against her parents wishes. Her husband turned out to be severely alcoholic and eventually after marriage started harassing her for monetary reasons. On her refusal to his demand of extorting money from her parents, he attempted to burn her and thus she was admitted to Sassoon General Hospital's Burns ward.

Along with precise treatment and palliative care by the doctors at the Sassoon General Hospital, SOFOSH too stepped in at this moment with the nutritional support coupled with the much needed emotional and moral support to the patient and the family members. Continuous counseling sessions added to her strength and eventually she agreed to change the false dying declaration she had made under her husband's pressure. This helped the police arrest her husband. By God's grace she has now been discharged from the hospital and is staying with her parents. •
